Ash Wednesday Starts Lent

The Lenten season is just around the corner. The word "lent" simply refers to the daylight hours getting longer during the coming months, but the focus of the season in church is on repentance for our sins as we remember our Savior's journey to the cross and his suffering and death. Ash Wednesday sets the tone for Lent. This year again, we will be giving our members the opportunity to receive the imposition of the ashes in one of our two Ash Wednesday services February 26th (1:30pm or 7:00pm). From the earliest days of history, ashes have symbolized sorrow, mourning and repentance. They cause us to think heavily about our sins for which our Savior died.
